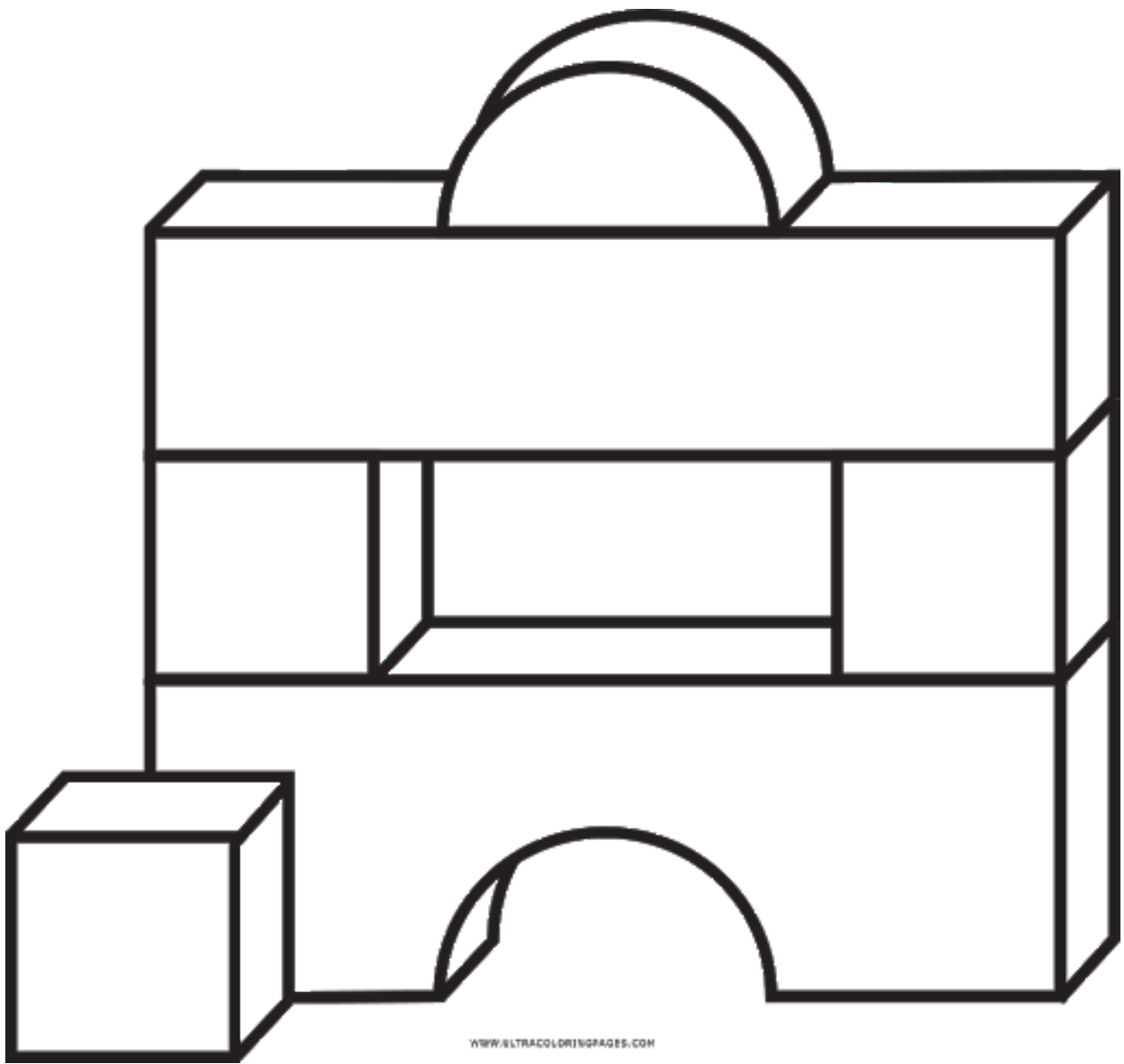

But we must each be careful how we build, ¹¹ because Christ is the only foundation. ¹²⁻¹³ Whatever we build on that foundation will be tested by fire on the day of judgment. Then everyone will find out if we have used gold, silver, and precious stones, or wood, hay, and straw. ¹⁴ We will be rewarded if our building is left standing. ¹⁵ But if it is destroyed by the fire, we will lose everything. Yet we ourselves will be saved, like someone escaping from flames. ¹⁶ All of you surely know that you are God's temple and that his Spirit lives in you. ¹⁷ Together you are God's holy temple, and God will destroy anyone who destroys his temple.

Do this at home!


Have a look in your garden or the plants you have inside. Draw what you see.

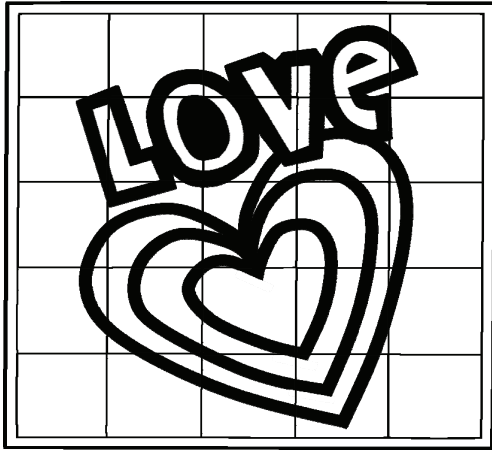

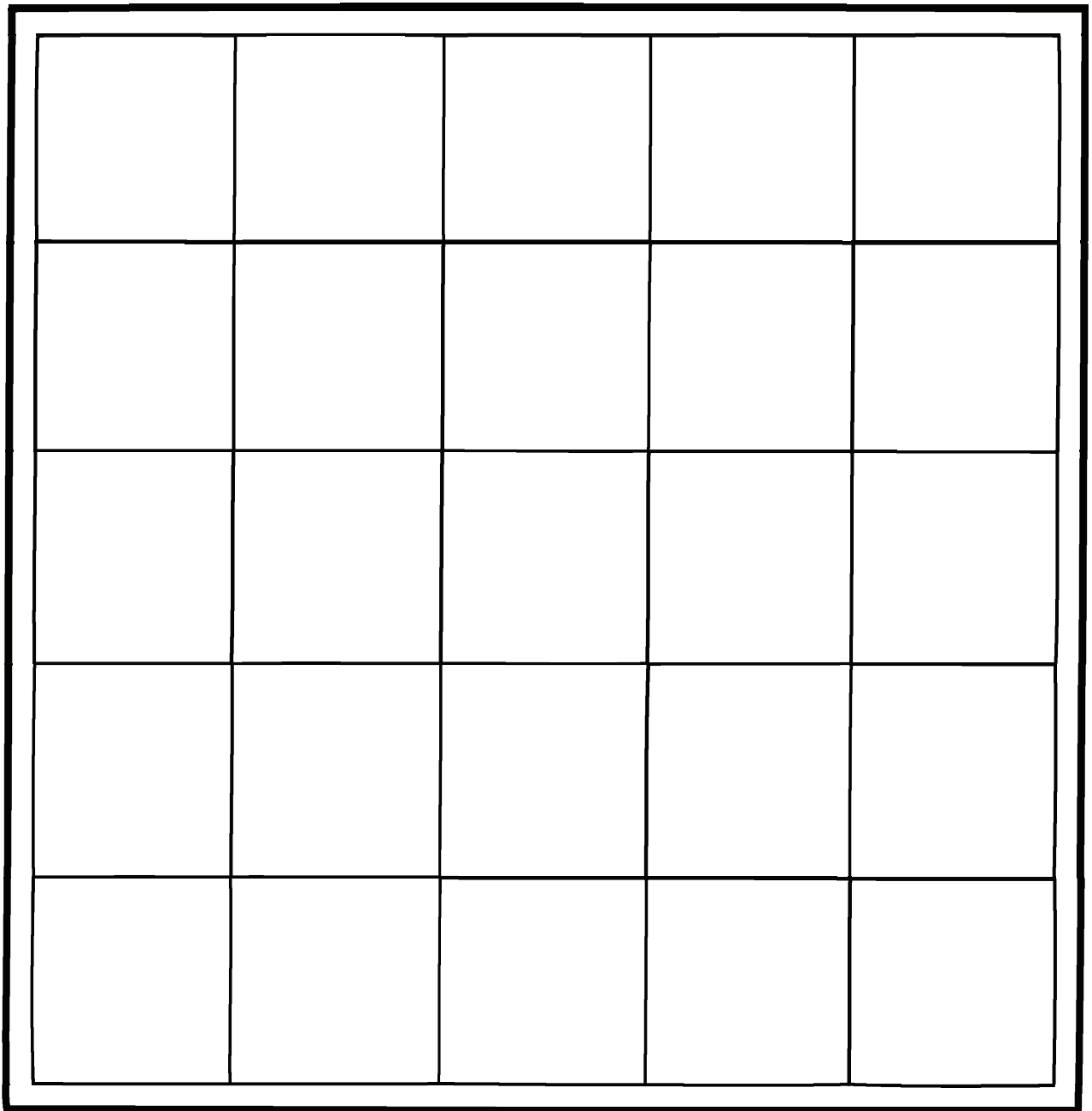
